Her research interest includes Asian products (starch and protein quality requirements for various Asian noodle styles) and baking systems and innovation in processing.

Larisa is an National Delegate for Australia to the International Association of Cereal Science and Technology (ICC), Board Director at the Cereals and Grains Association, technical committee co-chair for Asian Products and Bread Baking at the Cereals and Grains Association and technical member on the Wheat Council of the Grain Industry Association of Western Australia (GIWA).

Prior to joining AEGIC, Larisa worked as an Asian Product Specialist with AWB Ltd. and with the Department of Agriculture and Food WA to ensure the WA wheat industry was internationally competitive.
